Teams can apply for funding support of up to \$300 to support the costs of registration, travel, and other associated expenses. This is a limited offer and funding will be provided on a first-come basis.

TO BE ELIGIBLE:

Any community or school group that plans to participate in the upcoming HRC or FLL 2016/17 Robot Programming Competitions:

- The team must be comprised of 50% or more girls,
- 50% of the group must not have competed before in the *FIRST* LEGO League competition,
- The coach must ensure that the team knows who WISEatlantic is and is expected to visit our website,
- The coach must share WISEatlantic information (flyers, web resources etc) with the team (material can be provided by WISEatlantic),
- WISEatlantic is to be acknowledged on t-shirts, on the team table and in competition presentations. (We will provide our logo).
