



Team Sponsorship Application 2018/19

The NSERC Women in Science and Engineering - Atlantic Region Program (WISEatlantic) is offering funding to support a limited number of new teams that compete in [Robofest](#), [FIRST LEGO League](#) (FLL), and [Lets Talk Science Challenge](#) competitions.

Teams from any part of Atlantic Canada can apply for funding support of up to \$300 to support the costs of registration, travel, and other associated expenses. This is a limited offer and funding will be provided on a first-come basis. If your application is successful, ***please note that the funding cannot be provided up-front but instead through reimbursement with presentation of original receipt(s) OR by invoicing WISEatlantic for the \$300 and citing FLL/Robofest or Let's Talk Science Challenge Sponsorship. All receipts MUST be submitted for reimbursement by March 15, 2019***

TO BE ELIGIBLE:

Any community or school group that plans to participate in the upcoming Robofest, FLL 2018/19 Robot Programming Competitions or the Lets Talk Science Challenge that meet the following criteria:

- The team must be comprised of 50% or more girls;
- 50% of the group must not have competed before in any prior competition listed above;
- The coach or team leader must ensure that the team knows who WISEatlantic is and be prepared to share materials we send you to the team members;
- The coach or team leader must direct team members to the WISEatlantic website and we encourage the coach/team leader to play for the team one or more of the role model videos we have featured at <http://wiseatlantic.ca/role-model-videos/>
- WISEatlantic is to be acknowledged on t-shirts, on the team table and in competition presentations. (We will provide our logo).

DEADLINE:

Applications for 2018/19 will be accepted from May 1st, 2018 to September 28th, 2018. **You will be notified by October 15th, 2018 whether or not your team will receive funding support.**
